

### **UConn ECE**

- ▶ University of Connecticut courses offered in your high school.
- ► UConn course grades are based on demonstrated content mastery thoughout the course.
- Students earn a letter grade and credit on an official UConn transcript.
- ► UConn ECE offers 91 unique courses from 37 academic disciplines.
- ▶ UConn courses cost \$50 per credit, a 90% savings over the same course on campus.
- ▶ UConn credits earned through UConn ECE transfer to other colleges and universities 87% of the time!

## **Advanced Placement**

- ▶ College-level coursework offered through College Board.
- ▶ Content mastery is measured by a single standardized assessment or portfolio submission.
  - ➤ Students must earn a passing score of 3-5 to potentially be eligible for college credit.
- ▶ AP offers 38 subject area tests in 7 subject categories.
- ▶ AP exams cost between \$97-\$145 per exam.
- College board does not publicly release the acceptance rates of AP exams.
